Suggested Questions for Individual
Study or Group Discussion*



- How do you feel when you see someone begging on the street? What different emotions come up?
- Read *Mark 10:46-52*. If you were to film this episode, how would you set the scene?
- Why does the crowd rebuke Bartimaeus and seek to silence him? What does Bartimaeus' response reveal about him?
- What does Bartimaeus call Jesus? Why is this significant?
- Why does Jesus have the crowd call Bartimaeus rather than calling him himself? What is the effect on the crowd?
- Why does Jesus ask Bartimaeus what he wants?
- How does Bartimaeus demonstrate the faith that facilitates his healing? How does this contrast with others around Jesus, including his disciples?
- In what ways have you felt silenced like Bartimaeus? How can Bartimaeus be an example for you of perseverance?
- If Jesus asked you, "What do you want me to do for you?" how would you respond? What steps will you take to do that? How can your small group or others support and pray for you as you do?

For Family Discussion: Ask: *How do you feel when you see someone begging for money on the street? Read Mark 10:46-52. Ask: What type of person do you think Bartimaeus is? How does Bartimaeus show his faith and trust in Jesus? If Jesus asked you, "What do you want me to do for you?" what would you ask for?*
