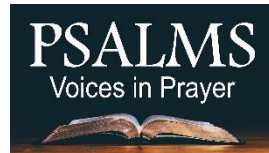

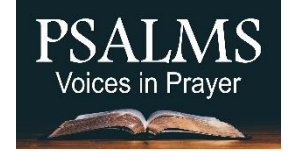

Suggested Questions for Individual  
Study or Group Discussion\*



- When you have felt all alone? Were you comfortable with it?
- Read *Psalm 22*. How would you describe the mood of this prayer? Give examples.
- Is the writer consistent in the prayer? What emotions are present?
- As you read through the psalm, what do you hear in your mind? What images?
- When in David's life do you think this psalm was written?
- How does this psalm point us to Jesus?
- When have you felt God's presence in your life? When have you felt God's absence?
- Does the psalm change tone? If so, in what way?
- What do you find in this prayer that gives you hope?
- How can this psalm be an example and guide for you in your own prayers?

**For Family Discussion:** Ask: *Do you remember the first time you were all alone? Read Psalm 22:1-21. Ask: Were there any parts of this psalm that did not make sense to you? When this person wrote the prayer, how do you think they were feeling? What are some ways they described God? What kinds of things do they want God to do for them? What could happen if God did those same things for you?*
