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Suggested Questions for Individual
Study or Group Discussion*



- What is a favorite restaurant to which you're eager to return? What makes it enjoyable or special?
- Read *Mark 14:12-26*. What are some of the elements used in a Passover meal? What do these elements symbolize and recall?
- What does Jesus have his disciples do to prepare to eat the Passover? What do his instructions reveal?
- What shocking announcement does Jesus make over dinner? How do his disciples receive the news? How do you think you would have reacted?
- How do you see divine sovereignty and human responsibility intersect in the Upper Room? In what ways do you also experience this?
- How does Jesus alter the Passover meal and to what ends? What is Jesus saying through his actions and the symbolism?
- What promises does Jesus make to his disciples through the meal? How do we receive these promises?
- What do you hear the Lord saying to you through this Scripture? How will you respond? How can your small group or others support and pray for you in this?

For Family Discussion: Ask: *What is your favorite restaurant? Read Mark 14:12-26. Ask: What does Jesus say one of his disciples will do? How do you think Jesus felt about that? What does Jesus say the bread and the cup of wine represent? What is Jesus teaching about why he died? What would you like to say to Jesus in response?*
