Suggested Questions for Individual Study or Group Discussion*



- · What is a favorite memory of a past Easter?
- Read *Luke 24:13-27*. If you were able to eavesdrop on the two disciples as the talked, what might you hear? What tone?
- Why do the disciples not recognize Jesus? What might God be doing in this?
- Why does Jesus take the disciples through the Hebrew Scriptures rather than reveal his identity? Where do you see Jesus in the Old Testament, in both the texts and themes?
- Read *Luke 24:28-35*. How would you compare and contrast this meal with others that people shared with Jesus?
- What causes the disciples to recognize Jesus finally? Why does Jesus disappear?
- How do you recognize Jesus in Scripture and in Sacrament? What helps you to do so? How can you help others to do so?
- Read *Luke 24:36-49*. How does Jesus reveal his identity and reassure his disciples?
- What task does Jesus give his disciples? What is the corresponding promise?
- How should we likewise embrace this task and promise in our day? How will we see and recognize the resurrected Christ when we do?
- To what is Jesus Christ calling on you to testify or bear witness? How and with whom will you do this? How can your small group or others support and pray for you in this?
