Suggested Questions for Individual
Study or Group Discussion*



- Do you agree with the statement: “We cannot be Christ-followers alone”? Why or why not?
- Read *Hebrews 10:23-25*. How would you summarize the exhortations in this Scripture?
- How does God’s faithfulness to us in Christ help us hold fast to God’s promises for us (v. 23)?
- What are concrete ways you have experienced someone spurring you on toward love and good deeds (v. 24)?
- What are some reasons why Christians give up meeting together (v. 25)? What are ways our church can counter that?
- How do spiritual companions or soul friendships differ from other relationships we might have?
- When have you experienced companionship in your spiritual journey? How did that relationship impact or influence you?
- Reflecting on your current relationships, with whom do you sense an opportunity for deeper sharing to encourage one another? How can you prayerfully pursue that?
- What would a church committed to companioning with one another look like? How can you and/or your small group help our congregation become more like that?
