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Suggested Questions for Individual Study or Group Discussion*



- When have you had to carry a heavy backpack or suitcase?
 How long did you need to carry it?
- Read Galatians 6:1-5. How do these instructions fit with the rest of Paul's letter, what you've studied in chapters 1-5?
- How would you summarize Paul's exhortations and warnings?
 What would be the impact on the community if the Galatians did this?
- How is Paul's counsel for restoring one caught in sin likely different from his rivals who want the Galatians to be "under the law"? How does it differ from today's versions of legalism?
- When have you seen the restoration of one caught in sin carried out well? What enabled this to happen?
- How can we test our actions and guard against misplaced pride when helping others?
- What is the "law of Christ"? When it is fulfilled, what does that look like in individuals and in a faith community?
- How is Jesus Christ an example of what Paul commands?
 How has Jesus restored you from being caught in sin and/or carried your burdens?
- What kinds of burdens are your brothers and sisters in Christ carrying these days? How is the church doing in responding?
- Without revealing personal details about another, how can you carry someone's burden this week? What concrete steps will you take to do so? How can your small group or others support and pray for you in this?
