Sabbatical Coming for Pastor Neil Trainer

// April 25 - August 1, 2022

As was shared at the recent congregational meeting and town hall, Pastor Neil Trainer will be receiving a sabbatical later this year.

A sabbatical gives pastors time away from the demands of daily ministry to engage in a period of reflection and renewal. This "Sabbath" time of respite may include travel, study, rest, immersive arts, cultural experiences, and prayer. After the sabbatical, pastors return to the responsibilities of ministry with renewed energy and vision.

Neil's sabbatical will focus on both learning and discerning. He will begin with a Renovaré retreat to refocus on Jesus. Then, he and his wife, Kristi, will

spend time traveling and learning. Beginning with a tour of the Adriatic with good friends, they will visit Slovenia and Croatia. They continue with a tour of Turkey, exploring a land filled with biblical sites and early Church history. Then they stop in Athens to visit with friends before returning home. As the jetlag subsides, Neil has expressed excitement about continuing to research early Church events and people associated with sites visited in Turkey, such as the creation of the Nicene Creed and the Cappadocian Fathers.

The second half of the sabbatical allows Neil time for discernment. Entering into his fifteenth year as Calvin's pastor, Neil will prayerfully explore ways to ensure health and vibrancy for both the congregation and minister in long-term pastorates. He will seek spiritual direction and mentoring around what the next season of pastoral ministry with Calvin Church will look like. He also aspires to complete a manuscript and develop a retreat centered on a formational reading of the Book of Ruth.

Neil's last Sunday with us before the sabbatical is April 24, the Sunday after Easter. He will return to the office on August 1. During his absence, Rev. Emily Mitchel will serve as the acting Head of Staff, moderate the Session, and take the lead in our Sunday worship.
