Suggested Questions for Individual Study or Group Discussion*



- Who are two or three people who have significantly helped you to know what daily following Jesus can look like? How did they do this?
- Read Matthew 4:18-23. What are some ways the lives of the fishermen change when they respond to Jesus' summons, "Follow me"?
- From your knowledge of the Gospels, in what kinds of activities does Jesus include his disciples? How does this affect their relationships with each other and form them into a community with Jesus at the center?
- Read John 17:20-23. For whom and what does Jesus pray?
 Where do you see this prayer being answered both in biblical times and in our time?
- Drawing upon Jesus' prayer, what then is the source and basis of unity for our church congregation? What practical effect should this have on our life together?
- Read Hebrews 10:19-25. What exhortations are given here?
 What does each mean? How can you increasingly do this with others?
- As we conclude this series, what spiritual practice(s) would you like to begin or continue in order to live life like Jesus?
 How might you do this with others? How can your small group or others support and pray for you in this?
