Suggested Questions for Individual Study or Group Discussion\*

- How does Jesus deal with his feelings of abandonment? How can this be instructive for us?
- In what ways is Jesus forsaken for our sakes?
- If a close friend asked you, "Why has God abandoned me?" how would you respond?
- Can you identify a time when God seemed distant or absent to you? To the level you are comfortable, can you share what that experience was like and what you did?
- How have you utilized Scripture in your prayers as Jesus did? How can Scripture be a resource for your prayers going forward? What concrete steps can you take this week to do that?
