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Suggested Questions for Individual
Study or Group Discussion*



- What does it feel like when someone doesn't believe what you say? How do you respond?
- Read Luke 24:1-12. If you were to give this gospel story a title, what would it be?
- How do you imagine the women felt on their way to the tomb? When they did not find Jesus' body? When they heard "he has risen"? When the Eleven did not believe them?
- What are some reasons why the other disciples might not have believed the things the women told them?
- What parts of the resurrection story have you wrestled with or still find hard to believe? What do you do with your questions or doubts?
- What is the difference between believing that Christ has risen, and believing in the risen Christ?
- What difference does the resurrection of Christ make in how you live your life?
- As we finish this series on the "Seven Last Words," through which one (including this week's additional word) has God continued to speak to you: *know, truth, here, forsaken, thirsty, finished, commend, or believe*? About which do you feel called to continue to speak to Jesus? How can your small group or others support and pray for you in this?
