// Walk for Water event last Saturday was a great success

Three cheers for Team Calvin and for all who came out to support the Walk for Water fundraiser for *Path from Poverty!* The entire PFP fundraiser raised nearly \$80,000 to help pay for water catchment tanks for women in rural Kenya – their most successful fundraiser to date. Team Calvin won the prize for the largest team, having 26 team members (not to mention the friends and supporters). By raising \$7,958, Team Calvin also won the prize for raising the most money among the various teams. The funds raised by Calvin will purchase water catchment tanks for five families as well as a solar panel for one family in Kenya.
