God is Faithful

I have had many challenges in my life. Looking back on them, I see God has carried me through every single time.

One of the hardest times in my life was when CPS found me negligent of improper care for a child, even though I had not harmed a child. I was removed from the teaching career I had spent my whole life developing. I spent 3.5 years battling CPS to clear my name. Many of my

friends, pastors, and mentors supported me emotionally, prayed for me, gave me help and guidance, and they were a soft place to fall when I needed them. I questioned God. I pleaded with God. But most of all, I trusted God would get me through. God would guide me to where he wanted me, even though it was very unclear where I would land.

The two verses that helped me keep faith that God would provide for me and I could endure what was happening to me were Philippians 4:13, "I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me" and Isaiah 40:29–31, "He gives power to the weak... but those who wait on the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles, they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint."

Within a year of me losing my teaching career, God provided a safe place for me to fight. The perfect job presented itself. It fit seamlessly with me being a doula. Many people recommended that I apply. I spoke to my pastor for guidance and he also encouraged me to apply. Within a couple weeks I became the Hospitality & Facilities Director at Calvin Presbyterian Church.

God has blessed me in this job in so many ways. I have become more confident in my abilities, in dealing with people, and in doing hard things. God has blessed my friendships and connections with people while being in this position. I also like to think that I have been a blessing to Calvin and those I

have worked with in the last seven years. God has truly given me strength when I was weary. With God I have persevered.
