Finance Team Update

We are now two months into our new fiscal year. How are Calvin's finances are doing? In short, things are great! Contributions were lighter than anticipated for July and August, but donations are often less during the summer months so it is not a great cause for concern at this point. Facilities revenue was also a bit down, but this is easily explained by the fact that it was summer (and also our Hospitality & Facilities Director was away for most of the month of August). Otherwise, operating expenses are very close to what we budgeted and expected. Here's a quick look at some figures:

- General Fund Contributions, July-August - \$78,240 (we budgeted for \$90,000)
- Facilities Revenue, July-August - \$2,348 (we'd hoped for \$6,000)
- Other Revenue, July-August -\$3,000
- TOTAL Operations Revenue. July-August — \$85,589
- Total Expenses, July-August - \$106,736 (giving to missions: \$12,375)
- Net Revenue, as of 8/31/2022 - (23,148)
- Total Assets, as of 8/31/2022 — \$830,138

Securing a Relationship with Christ

Years ago I attended a Basic Youth Conflicts conference at the Seattle Center Arena at the invitation of a close friend, and it was here that I first accepted Christ. The direction we got at the conclusion of the conference was to **seek out a church** where our newfound relationship with Christ could be nurtured to grow. Within a month I found myself at Greenlake Presbyterian Church and through the worship services I began to learn the lessons that the Bible had for me. (Interestingly, that particular church just north of Woodland Park to the west of Aurora Avenue was known for the large iron bible it displayed on its outside wall.)

Once there, all those attending were encouraged to get involved in a small group. The neighborhood group I was assigned to included some in my demographic (singles in their 20s), parents with young families, and grandparents. In this group we shared life, explored the Bible or a Christian book together, learned from each other's life experiences. prayed for each other, and made friendships that still endure.

Lastly, one person set aside time to **be my close friend** and to mentor me in a Paul/Timothy relationship. The success of my

relationship with Christ was so important to him so he invested some of his valuable time to meet with me regularly.

For me, all of these things helped to build a lasting Christian faith. It worked for me: be actively involved with a Christ-centered church, a small group, and a close friend.
