Suggested Questions for Individual Study or Group Discussion*



- What is one of your favorite mystery movies or novels? What makes this a favorite?
- *Read Ephesians 3:1–13.* As Paul seems to interrupt himself, how would you summarize his digression here? What does he seek to emphasize before moving on?
- In what different ways does Paul describe himself? How does this connect to his own story? To which can you relate and why?
- What is the grace given to Paul? What responsibility comes with God's grace?
- What is the mystery about which Paul writes? How has God revealed this mystery?
- What privileges have the Gentiles gained? How did God accomplish this?
- How does Paul say we may now approach God? How can this affect the way in which you pray, whether alone or with others?
- What does Paul reveal about his view of the nature and purpose of the Church? How does this compare to your own views?
- How can our congregation better live into God's plan for the Church as revealed here? What can you do to be a part of that work? How can your small group or others support and pray for you as you do this?
