Suggested Questions for Individual Study or Group Discussion*



- How can love and power be related? What are some examples?
- *Read Ephesians 3:14–21.* List the things for which Paul prays.
- What is revealed in this passage about the Triune God's nature, character, and ways of working in the world? How does this align with your perception and expectations of God?
- How does Paul link love and power in his prayer for the Ephesian Christians? How does Paul pray for the Ephesians to experience both?
- Of the things for which Paul prays, which most captures your attention or imagination? For which do you most long and why?
- If God answered Paul's prayer in significant and observable ways, what would you see happen among the Ephesian Christians?
- To what extent has Paul's prayer been answered in the life of our congregation? What examples can you give? Where is more still needed?
- When was a time in which you grasped the love of Christ in a profound way? What has been the impact upon your life?
- How can Paul's prayer be an example for you to follow as you pray for others? How might you pray like Paul this week? How can your small group or others support and pray for you as you do this?
