How Generous Is Our God?

// Finance Team Update

"Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good; his love endures forever." - Psalm 107:1

How great is God's grace and provision? How generous is our God? Calvin witnessed God's provision in December in two dramatic ways. First, our congregation gave over \$106,000 in year-end gifts to the general fund. This generous outpouring of support has moved our church's budget from a significant deficit at the end of November to a modest surplus on December 31st and will help to ensure our ministries are fully funded for the 2022-23 fiscal year.

The church was doubly blessed in December when it received a gift of \$225.760 from the estate of our long-time member Geri Johns. Throughout her life, Geri was a generous contributor to our church, especially to building improvement projects. Geri placed no restrictions on how this gift should be used, so Session is taking time to prayerfully discern how these funds can best further our church's vision and mission. At its meeting last Tuesday, Session did allocate \$50,000 from these funds to support projects being considered by our Property Team, including the repainting of our building. Session will update the congregation as it discerns how to employ this generous bequest to grow God's kingdom.

By the numbers... December giving has put us in a very good position as we move

into the second half of our fiscal year. Contributions are now at 96% of what we had anticipated, while expenses also continue to be less than we expected. Facilities revenue is continuing strong, bringing in more income than we had hoped to receive.

Here are some numbers:

- General Fund Contributions. July-Dec: \$302,234 (we budgeted for \$315,000);
- Facilities Revenue, July-Dec: \$27,708 (our budget expected \$20,000);
- Other Revenue, July-Dec: \$238,188 (includes bequest income);
- **TOTAL Operations Revenue**, July-Dec: \$568,130;
- Total Expenses, July-Dec: \$327,801 (giving to missions: \$43,900);
- Net Revenue as of 12/31/2022: \$232.432:
- Total Assets as of 12/31/2022: \$1,102,883 (a jump of over \$300K).
