How God Led Me to Seattle

I spent years as an idealistic young humanist until shortly before the death of both my parents within the space of eight months. About a year before that I had committed my life to Christ after reading the Gospel of John for the first time. Suddenly alone in the world, with neither siblings nor spouse, I decided to start a new life somewhere out on the West Coast.

I settled on Seattle, where I didn't know a soul, so I wrote to a couple I knew who had once lived here briefly and asked them if they knew of any place where I could stay while getting established. They didn't, but said there was a Christian place called King's Garden (now CRISTA Ministries), which they thought sometimes hosted visitors.

I phoned King's Garden, only to be told that they normally just housed missionaries on furlough, but that they could keep me for three days.

Utterly exhausted by the radical move and the long, solo drive from Florida, I ended up staying there for three *months*. After that I rented an apartment in the home of a King's Garden high school student, where I lived for the next seven years — until my marriage in 1975.

The subsequent chapters of my life have been marked by a sequence of *truly* uncanny "coincidences," in which I see the hand of a loving and all-knowing Father, who will never leave me nor forsake me.
