// Healing trauma and providing leadership training in Cambodia

This month we're highlighting Calvin's connections to Cambodia. Calvin's long-term partnership in Cambodia has primarily been with Mission DOVE Cambodia (DOVE).

In Cambodia, trauma is passed down by a community still struggling with the genocide that occurred in the late 70's and with civil unrest that persisted until 1998. Parents have passed on trauma and emotional dysfunction to the younger generation. DOVE provides a safe haven and Christian training to help young adults move on to live productive lives as followers of Jesus. This work is vital and is strategically implemented through two program areas.

First, the YES-IC Drop In Center is where community children and teens can come to temporarily escape life stresses, play games, and enjoy classes in English, guitar, computers, and more in a safe environment. Under the leadership of the director, Virak, quests are welcomed and loved. Many learn about the Gospel by witnessing staff compassion, and they often come to accept Jesus into their hearts.

Second, ONYX Programs I and II are special 10-month intensive

trainings aimed at healing trauma and guiding young believers into mature, productive lives and ministry in Christ.

There is a saying at DOVE that if you don't transform trauma, you will transfer it to others. The goal at DOVE is to break that cycle through the love of Christ shown by mentors and staff as well as through collaborative learning. There is not a more worthwhile partnership for Calvin than this one working in a Buddhist country led by a despot where life is very hard. We, and DOVE, seek to grow the Kingdom of God in Cambodia and beyond throughout Southeast Asia.

Hearing God's Voice

Many Christians share their experiences of "hearing God's voice."

I have not had any experience like that until recently, and it demonstrated to me that God is interested in even the smallest things in our lives.

We are planning and preparing for a trip to the East Coast to see the fall colors and visit old friends. One of our planned stops is to Acadia National Park in Maine. When I turned 62 several years ago, I got a lifetime Senior pass to all national parks for \$10 (the same pass costs \$80 today). I had not visited a national park in a few years, so I started looking for my creditcard-sized pass to take on

the trip. I could not find it anywhere! I was mad at myself for not being able to find it and was resigned to purchasing another pass before we leave for our trip. I had even prayed about finding it, but no luck.

Then, when I was retrieving tickets for an arts event in an arts file in our house. I heard a voice saying, "Take another look." When I looked into the bottom of the file, saw the national park pass and recognized what it was, I started crying because I knew it was God talking to me. I would never have looked in that location for my pass and still don't know how it got there. Through this experience God was telling me that He cares about even the smallest things in my life if I would only open my heart to Him.
