Ash Wednesday Service

// Wednesday, February 22 at 7 pm in the Sanctuary

Ash Wednesday is the first day of Lent, a 40-day season in the Christian year where we focus on repentance and reflection. It is a preparation for Easter, which occurs on the 46th day after Ash Wednesday. (Even though there are 46 days between the start of Lent and Easter Sunday, Sundays are not counted as part of Lent hence, 40 days.)

Calvin will start the season of Lent with a special mid-week service to celebrate Ash Wednesday. The service will be at 7 pm in the Sanctuary and will offer meditative readings and music to help us reflect on our mortality and need for a Savior and to express our union with, and gratitude for, Christ, the One who has conquered sin and death. Worship with us in-person or online.

Lenten Bible Readings

This Lent, we invite you to participate in our congregationwide Bible reading plan. Watch for a letter and bookmark which will be arriving in your mailbox this week. The bookmark lists the readings for each day, and the readings can also be accessed through the "Lenten Readings" button on the homepage of our church website (the button is available now, but the readings won't

start until Ash Wednesday). On the website, you'll be able to post comments, share insights, and ask questions. We look forward to hearing your thoughts and reflections as we study God's word together.

Mission Partner Brian Maher

// Advisor, DOVE Cambodia

Calvin has been supporting the missionary Brian Maher for a number of years now. Brian works in Cambodia as an advisor for DOVE (another Calvin mission partner). Some of you may have met him and his family when they visited us last summer, or you may have met him on a prior trip back to this area.

Brian is married to Bophal, and they have two children. Brian holds an MA in Cross-Cultural Studies from Fuller Seminary and has been serving in Cambodia since 1994. He's currently training emerging church leaders and doing men's work. He's also the author of Cry of the Gecko, a book about evangelical Christian mission in Cambodia. His wife, Bophal, started a center for at-risk children in 2001. In addition to her work at the center, she's active in training leaders through DOVE.

Next Sunday we'll learn a bit more about Brian Maher and Lynn Ogata's work with DOVE as we watch a short video they made.

Calvin will be offering *The* Sanctuary Course on Sundays at 11:30 am in the Library,

beginning next Sunday on February 26th and running through April 23rd. The Sanctuary Course explores how church can become a sanctuary a place where individuals living with mental health challenges feel safe and supported and have a sense of belonging.

Developed in consultation with mental health professionals, theologians, and people with lived experience, this eightsession study explores key mental health topics and examines meaningful ways to offer companionship, support recovery, and promote wellbeing.
