Finance Team Update

// A snapshot of our financials as of January 31, 2023

January giving was a bit more modest than it was in December. but we are still in a good position financially. Contributions to date are about 96% of what the budget anticipated and expenses are also lighter. Facilities revenue also continues to perform much better than we expected.

Here's a quick look at some figures:

- General Fund Contributions, July-Jan: \$352,693 (we budgeted for \$367,000);
- Facilities Revenue, July-Jan: \$35,461 (our budget expected \$23,500);
- Other Revenue, July-Jan: \$190,806 (includes beguest income):
- **TOTAL** Operations Revenue, July-Jan: \$578,960.
- Total Expenses, July-Jan: \$386,835 (giving to missions: \$50,088).
- Net Revenue, as of 1/31/2023: \$192.126.
- Total Assets, as of 1/31/2023: \$1,080,884.

Those of you with eagle eyes may notice that our bequest income appears to be less than it was last month. This is because Session designated \$50,000 to go to building and grounds projects, so that amount is now in another line item to be used as Session has designated.

Thank you all for your continued support of the mission and ministries of Calvin church! As always, if you have any financial concerns, please feel free to
