Suggested Questions for Individual Study or Group Discussion\*



- What is your least favorite job to do when it comes to housework? Why?
- *Read John 13:1–17.* What do you imagine the mood in the room would have been like as Jesus and his twelve disciples gathered for this supper?
- What things does Jesus know that the disciples do not? How does this shape what Jesus says and does? What about Jesus' actions is surprising or contrary to normal expectations?
- What is Simon Peter's initial and then subsequent response to Jesus washing his feet? What might be behind that?
- Why does Jesus insist on washing Peter's feet, but only his feet? What does Jesus mean by "you are clean"?
- What specific lessons is Jesus seeking to impart to his apprentices? How will their lives and relationship be shaped if they understand and apply these lessons?
- In what ways do you need Jesus to "wash your feet" as he did the twelve disciples?
- Who do you know who has followed Jesus' command and example to "wash one another's feet"? What did this person do, and what was the impact?
- What is one way you can follow Jesus' example this week? How will you do that? How can your small group or others support and pray for you?
