Stephen Ministry and the Power of Listening

// This month's ministry focus is on Calvin's Stephen Ministers

If you wish to understand what Stephen Ministers do, perhaps the best place to start is with Paul's exhortation to the Galatians: "Carry each other's burdens, and in that way you will fulfill the law of Christ (Galatians 6:2)."

Stephen Ministers are lay people who are committed to the ministry of presence — to walk alongside others in times of need and listen to their yearnings, hopes, heartbreaks, and joys. All too often people long to be heard but wonder if anyone wants to listen. Stephen Ministers are people who will say, "Yes, I want to listen to you, not just today, but in the days, weeks, and months ahead."

Stephen Ministers are not professional counselors, but before they begin to serve they must complete six months of training: a time of extensive reading and practice in the art

of listening while also learning how to be present for others in times of crisis, loss, struggle, and grief. Stephen Ministers don't pretend to have the "answers." Instead, they will walk with you in your journey toward healing and wholeness.

Generally, Stephen Ministers will meet with you once a week. All discussions are strictly confidential. Your sense of safety and trust is essential. This ministry is available for both men and women of all ages. Each stage of life brings its unique challenges, and an understanding, non-judgmental ear can be an enormous support.

Right now, Calvin has four active Stephen Ministers: Katy Korpi, Dave Randles, Donna Miller Parker, and Rick Jackson. If you think you would like to speak with a Stephen Minister, please contact Pastor Emily and she will connect you with a Stephen Minister.
