April 2023 Finance Summary

// Slightly over a month left in our fiscal year

Calvin's finances are doing well, thanks in part to bequest funds as well as to a significant one-time gift. However, our continued financial health relies primarily on the faithfulness of your giving. As we approach the end of our fiscal year, it's particularly important for you to fulfill your pledges and then to give as the Spirit leads you. Session has reviewed a first draft of next year's budget and is prayerfully considering staffing needs as well as ministry directions for the future. Please continue to pray for wisdom and insight as we discern how

God would have us allocate Calvin's funds.

Fiscal Year-to-Date Summary (July 2022 – April 2023)

- General Fund Contributions: \$536,963 (exceeding our budgeted \$523,000)
- Facilities Revenue: \$51,463 (also exceeding our budgeted \$34,000)
- Other Revenue: \$201,799 (includes bequest income)
- Total Operations Revenue: \$790,225
- Total Expenses: \$572,334 (giving to missions \$72,538)
- Net Revenue: \$217,891Total Assets: \$1,095,665
