### **End of Fiscal Year Soon**

#### // May 2023 Finance Summary

The final day of Calvin's fiscal year is Friday, June 30th, just five days away. Please make sure your pledges are up to date, and, if the Spirit calls you to do so, consider making an extra donation to end the year strong. Session has prayerfully approved a budget for next fiscal year: the bequest funds received in the past year give Calvin the opportunity to invest in some new directions that we hope will help the church grow and thrive. However, for all usual expenses the church relies on the faithfulness of

*your giving* and that is why it is so critical to end the fiscal year on a strong note. Thank you for your continued generosity!



### // Fiscal Year-to-Date Summary (July 2022 – May 2023)

- General Fund Contributions: \$570,939 (a bit under our budgeted \$575,000);
- Facilities Revenue: \$54,446 (better than our budgeted \$37,500);
- Other Revenue: \$202,522 (includes bequest income);
- Total Operations Revenue: \$827,907;
- Total Expenses: \$631,409 (giving to missions: \$77,725);
- NET REVENUE: \$ 207,430;
- Total Assets: \$1,066,543.

### **Reminder About Parking**

// Painting begins this week; be careful where you park

Calvin's painting project gets underway this week. Power washing begins tomorrow, June 26. Your cars will be fine parked wherever you want while the power washing occurs. However, painting will begin mid-week – possibly on Wednesday, 6/28, but more likely on Thursday, 6/29 – and will take two to three weeks to complete. While painting is underway, make sure your cars are parked at least 50 feet away from wherever it is being painted so as not to damage your cars with a fine mist of paint. The painters plan to start at the north side of the church, then do the east side, and after that work their way around. If you are concerned about damage to your car, the safest place to park during the weeks that Calvin will be painted is on top of the hill; otherwise, we recommend parking on the far side of the parking lot from the building.
