// Calvin's fiscal year ends on a strong note

Thanks to your generosity, Calvin's finances remain firm and robust. When the budget was approved last year, we expected that we would run a deficit all year long. But instead of the deficit, we have a sizable surplus of \$197,067, largely due to a substantial bequest we received during the 2022–23 fiscal year. God is very good!

// Fiscal year-end summary (July 2022 – June 2023)

- General Fund Contributions: \$633,320 (a wee bit under our budgeted \$635,000);
- Facilities Revenue: \$58,844 (much better than our budgeted \$41,000!);

- Other Revenue: \$202,528 (includes bequest income);
- Total Operations Revenue: \$894,692;
- Total Expenses: \$697,624 (giving to missions: \$86,800);
- NET REVENUE: \$197,067;
- Total Assets: \$1,068,106.

Quarterly contribution statements were mailed out last week, so you should expect to see yours soon.
