Suggested Questions for Individual Study or Group Discussion\*



- When was a time when you felt like an outsider or a foreigner?
  Where were you? How were you treated?
- Read Deuteronomy 10:12-22. What themes do you see carrying through these instructions from the LORD which Moses gives to the Israelites?
- How is the LORD described? What is highlighted about God's character and priorities? How is this foundational for the commands that are given?
- How are the Israelites to treat those who are foreigners, sojourners, or immigrants living among them? What rationale is given for this?
- How does God view immigrants who live in your city or region?
  As God's people, how can Christians actively see them the same way and treat them accordingly?
- What are some of the common experiences of those living in your community who have immigrated from another country? What needs might they have that the Church could meet?
- Who are some immigrants with whom you're acquainted, either people you know or people you see frequently? How can you genuinely love them as God does? What are you going to do? How can your small group or others support and pray for you as you do this?
