God in the Midst

- What is a place in nature where you have felt close to God? What about this place conveys God's presence to you?
- *Read Psalm 104:1–35.* What catches your attention or stands out to you from this hymn of praise to God as Creator? What questions arise for you?
- What does the psalm reveal about who God is and about God's nature and character? What can we learn about God from this song?
- How does the psalmist describe the ways in which God relates to and interacts with Creation? How does all Creation respond?
- If humankind was created in God's image and given charge over the created world (Gen. 1:26–28), how then should we relate to and interact with Creation as God does? Where do you see examples in the Church and in society of our doing this well? Where is work needed?
- In what regular actions do you already engage to practice environmental stewardship? What practice would you like to add or do more?
- What prevents us from seeing and experiencing God's presence in Creation more freely and frequently? What helps you to do so?
- What can you do this week, alone or with others, to engage God in the midst of Creation? How can your small group or others support and pray for you as you do so?
