Mission Focus on Bridge Disability Ministries

Bridge Disability Ministries and Calvin have partnered in serving those living with disabilities for nearly 30 years.

Bridge fulfills this mission through three ministries. First, we are a bridge to physical access in the world. We accept donations of new and used durable medical equipment (wheelchairs, scooters, walkers, canes, etc.), refurbish them, and then give them away to those in need. Our Medical Equipment Ministry gave away over \$4 million in durable medical

equipment to over 2,000 individuals last year.

Second, we are a bridge to protection for those who need a legal guardian to represent them in areas of finance, health care, and shelter. Our Guardianship Ministry now serves over 40 individuals with developmental disabilities. Many of the people we serve have little family support and few financial resources.

Third, we are a bridge to inclusion and belonging in area churches and faith communities. Our Spiritual Connections Ministry connects hundreds of persons with disabilities to area churches.

This afternoon Calvin will host a Sunday Celebration, a time of fellowship, food, and fun that connects our congregants with people that Bridge serves.

Bridge Disability Ministries thanks Calvin for its support over so many years and looks forward to many more years of partnering with Calvin in serving and embracing people living with disabilities.

This past month expenses were again greater than our income. However, it is still quite early in the fiscal year and summer contributions have historically been light.
