Suggested Questions for Individual Study or Group Discussion\*



- How were sex and sexuality addressed in your home growing up? How has that impacted you positively and/or negatively?
- Read Genesis 1:26–28; 2:18, 21–25; 4:1–2. Where are there explicit or implicit references to sex and sexuality in these verses?
- What can we deduce from these Scriptures about God's good intent and design for human sexuality? Why has God made us sexual beings like we are?
- How is human sexuality different from the ways animals engage in sex? How should our being made in the image and likeness of God guide our understanding of our sexuality?
- If Jesus was fully human and like us in every way except without sin, then where can we see evidence of Jesus living out his own sexuality? What might we learn from him?
- How does evil corrupt God's good purposes for sex and sexuality? How does the Gospel of Jesus Christ point us to God's redemptive response?
- How is God present in the midst of sex? Specifically for a Christian, what might the Holy Spirit be doing when a person engages in sexual activity?
- What are ways you can embrace a Christ-centered sexuality apart from explicitly sexual acts? How does this also fulfill God's design for us?
- What do you find challenging about embracing God in the midst of your sexuality? How can your small group or others support and pray for you as you do so?
