# Watch Out for Fraudulent Text Messages

// Please, please, please be careful!

Someone is again impersonating Pastor Neil, this time through text messages. Quite a few members of the congregation were targeted this week, so we urge you to be on the lookout and to think carefully before responding to texts.

The scammers have members' cell phone numbers and send messages like the one pictured below. Watch out for: 1) The phrasing that doesn't sound like the person who is supposedly sending it; and 2) The cell phone number isn't one that you know.

No one from the church is ever going to email you or text you to ask you to get a gift card from Costco or Amazon or any other place. If you see that, don't believe it.

When in doubt, call the church office to check that a text is real before responding. The scammers have already had success with their scheme here at Calvin, so please be very careful.


