- What are some ways we hear the words “blessed” or “blessing” used in our society today? How is this similar to or different from the ways these words are used in Scripture?
- *Read 1 Chronicles 29:10–22a.* What is the occasion and setting for the scene described here? What do you imagine to be the mood or spirit of David and the people who have assembled?
- What are ways in which the LORD has blessed David and the Israelites? What does this reveal about God’s character and God’s heart for his people?
- How does David bless his son, Solomon? How does David bless all the people?
- How does the whole assembly seek to bless the LORD their God? What role do sacrifice, thanksgiving, and celebration play for them in blessing God?
- How do David’s prayer and actions provide a good model for ways we too can receive God’s blessings? How would you like to follow his example?
- What are ways in which we can bless others with our words and actions?
- Who are people you find easy to bless? Who are people you find more difficult? How can you bless one of each this week?
- In what ways will you bless God this week? What specifically will you say and do? Who will you invite to join you in this?
