Ash Wednesday Service

// Wednesday, Feb. 14 at 7 pm in the Sanctuary

Ash Wednesday is the first day of Lent, a 40-day season in the Christian year where we focus on repentance and reflection. It is a preparation for Easter, which occurs on the 46th day after Ash Wednesday. (Even though there are 46 days between the start of Lent and Easter Sunday, Sundays are not counted as part of Lent — hence, 40 days.)

Calvin will start the season of Lent with a special mid-week service to celebrate Ash Wednesday. The service will be at 7 pm in the Sanctuary on February 14 and will offer meditative readings and music to help us reflect on our mortality and need for a Savior and to express our union with, and gratitude for, Christ, the One who has conquered sin and death. Report on Tall Timber Ranch

// Year-end update on our mission partner

As you may recall, our longtime mission-partner Tall Timber Ranch was struggling after the pandemic. Fewer guests meant income was down, and finances were in disarray. Needed renovations could not occur. However, with a new director in charge, Rev. Adam Tobey, things have started to turn around. 2023 has been a much better year for Tall Timber. They served over 2,700 guests this past year — 1,000 more guests than the prior year!

In the past year, Tall Timber has deepened its connection with historically-marginalized communities, serving more ethnically-diverse churches, and expanding partnerships with schools on both sides of the Cascade mountains. Major improvements to the lodging facilities included renovating one building, adding new flooring to another, and putting a new roof onto a third building. There have been updates on the residences and other buildings; Tall Timber also

celebrated the opening of a new cabin.

Finances have improved through donations, grants, and PUD incentives (such as replacing all the old water heaters). The camp has found new ways for people to support Tall Timber through wishlists, auctions, gift-in-kind opportunities, and even investment loans. Staffing was able to increase again so Tall Timber finished 2023 with a full-time team of six people.
