All: **We confess to you, O God.**

One: Our negligence in prayer and worship, and our failure to commend the faith that is in us,

All: **We confess to you, O God.**

One: Accept our repentance, O God, for the wrongs we have done.

For our neglect of human need and suffering and our indifference to injustice and cruelty,

All: **Accept our repentance, O God.**

One: For all false judgments, for uncharitable thoughts toward our neighbors and our prejudice and contempt toward those who differ from us,

All: **Accept our repentance, O God.**

One: For our waste and pollution of your creation and our lack of concern for those who come after us,

All: **Accept our repentance, O God.**

One: Restore us, O God, and let your anger depart from us.

All: **Favorably hear us, O God, for your mercy is great.**
