

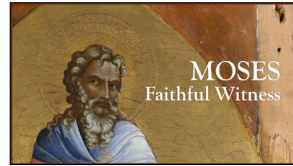

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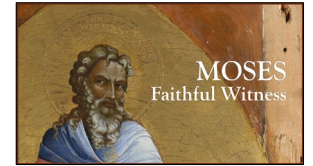

## Witness God's Glory

Exodus 33:12–23; 34:5–7

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Suggested Questions for Individual Study or Group Discussion\*



- How would you define “glory”? When is a time when you have seen or experienced God’s glory?
- *Read Exodus 33:12–23; 34:5–7.* How would you describe the relationship between the LORD and Moses in this passage?
- Why does Moses so greatly desire that God’s presence go not only with him but all the people? What will God’s presence reveal both to the Israelites and to others?
- Why might Moses have asked to see the LORD’s glory? How does the LORD choose to satisfy Moses’ request?
- Of the ways in which God describes himself before Moses (Ex. 34:6–7), which stand out as important to you today and why?
- How does the LORD’s self-revelation fit with your experience of God? Which aspects of God’s character and actions seem most familiar, and which do you need to grow to know better?
- How does Jesus embody the character qualities the LORD displayed to Moses? How does Jesus possess God’s glory and reveal that glory to us (Jn. 1:14)?
- When have you felt God’s presence with you? What contributed to that awareness? How can you more regularly “practice the presence of God”? How can your small group or others support and pray for you as you do this?
