Suggested Questions for Individual
Study or Group Discussion*



- What is a memory you have of a past Easter? What made Easter meaningful for you that year?
- *Read Luke 24:1–12.* How would you describe these events and their significance to someone who has never heard about Jesus and his resurrection?
- What different thoughts and feelings might these disciples have experienced upon finding the tomb of Jesus empty and hearing the declaration of the heavenly messengers?
- *Read Luke 24:13–35.* Why do you think these two followers of Jesus did not recognize him? What do they get right about Jesus, and what do they misunderstand?
- How does Jesus reveal to these disciples his purpose as well as his identity?
- *Read Luke 24:36–53.* Why are the disciples troubled and doubting when Jesus appears? What are the different ways in which Jesus proves it's really him?
- What assignment does Jesus give his disciples? What assistance will they have in completing it? How does this apply to Christians today and to our church?
- How does the resurrected Christ reveal himself to us today? How have you encountered Jesus personally?
- How can the reality of Easter impact the way we live each day? What is one thing you want to begin or continue in light of Christ's resurrection? How can your small group or others support and pray for you as you do?
