February 2024 Finance Summary

// Calvin continues to have a sound financial position

February contributions were more modest than in December and January, but our financial picture is still looking good. We anticipated that we would run a deficit this fiscal year by adding a new staff position, but our hope is that the new Director of Community Engagement position will reward our investment as new, stronger connections are made with our nearby neighbors. Because we hired later than we expected, our budget anticipated a larger deficit than we currently actually have. That's the good news. We do expect expenses to increase some in the remainder of this fiscal year. However, if contributions continue to remain steady, with an extra gift thrown in here and there, then we will finish the year strong. Thank you. We so appreciate your faithful generosity!

// Here's a quick look at the numbers for July 2023 – February 2024

- General Fund Contributions: \$404,313 (our budget hoped for \$442,000);
- Facilities Revenue: \$47,297 (a bit better than our budgeted \$44,500);
- Other Revenue: \$40,918;
- Total Operations Revenue: \$492.528:
- Total Expenses: \$503,469 (giving to missions: \$57,379);
- NET REVENUE: \$(10,941);
- Total Assets: \$949,361.

We are about to enter into budget season at Calvin. We

would appreciate your prayers as we discern funding for our ministries and mission partners. Pray for wisdom and for God's faithful provision of our needs.
