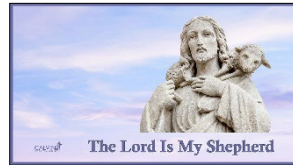

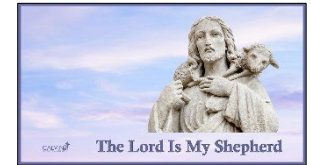

Suggested Questions for Individual
Study or Group Discussion*



- Choose five words or short phrases to describe yourself. How many of them are relational terms?
- What words or phrases would you use to describe your relationship with God, Jesus, or the Holy Spirit?
- If you are able, think back on a time when you felt like you were in a “valley of deepest darkness.” Looking back, are you able to see where God was “with you” as the psalmist confidently proclaims?
- Sometimes the way God shows up in these times of great need is in the form of a friend or loved one. Who has been “Jesus” to you in times of need?
- What are tangible ways you could be “Jesus” to someone in your community who may be in need? How can you or your small group shine a light into this person’s dark valley?
- How does your identity in Christ shape the way you view the world around you? The way you view your neighbor?
- Lastly, what are you afraid of? Can you name it and let Jesus have that fear?
