Suggested Questions for Individual  
Study or Group Discussion\*



- What are some scenarios in which you might be pursued? What does it feel like to be followed? How can this be positive or negative?
- *Read Psalm 23. (Use several translations if possible.)* In what ways does verse 6 capture themes present earlier in the psalm?
- Drawing on your knowledge of ways the terms are used elsewhere in Scripture, how would you define both “goodness” and “love” that are used in Psalm 23:6? How are each from God? How are both seen or experienced in someone’s life?
- What is meant by “the house of the LORD”? Practically speaking, how might someone dwell or live there?
- How does Jesus embody and enact both God’s goodness and God’s love? In what specific ways have you experienced this?
- How can the promises of Psalm 23:6 impact “all the days” of your life, including today? What would that be like for you? What is the Lord’s invitation to you in this?
- What is a way you can further receive and trust God’s goodness and love for you in Christ Jesus? What step can you take this week to do so? How can your small group or others support and pray for you as you do this?
- Looking back on our study of the 23rd Psalm, what has “the LORD is my shepherd” grown to mean to you? What have you learned about God and/or yourself? For what can you give God thanks today?
