April Finance Summary

// Pray for wisdom and discernment in Calvin's budget process

We give thanks to God that contributions in April were stronger than in prior months, and we're grateful to those who have given generously. Overall, however, we are bringing in less income than we had projected we might for this fiscal year. As of the end of April, we are nearly \$50,000 short of what we anticipated receiving based on past giving. If income is down, this has an obvious impact on next year's budget.

Despite a dip in revenue, Calvin is still quite healthy financially. The goal is to be good stewards — we want to ensure that our choices this year will not leave us in a precarious situation five years down the line.

Please pray that the Holy Spirit will grace our leaders with both wisdom and faith as they make difficult funding choices in the coming weeks. Ideally, we hope not to cut any programming or to delay hiring personnel. So ask God to provide the resources needed to support Calvin's ministries, and prayerfully consider whether the Lord is leading you to increase your financial giving to Calvin. And, in all things, give thanks to God who has always been faithful in providing for our congregation's needs.

// Here are the numbers for July 2023 – April 2024

 General Fund Contributions: \$501,410 (our budget hoped for \$550,000);

- Facilities Revenue: \$68,259 (beating our budgeted \$58,300);
- Other Revenue: \$45,003;
- Total Operations Revenue: \$614,672;
- Total Expenses: \$639,661 (giving to missions \$72,204);
- Net Revenue: \$(24,989); and
- Total Assets: \$942,837.
