May Finance Summary

// Continue to pray for wisdom and discernment in Calvin's budget process

May contributions were strong, matching the budget target and then adding in a bit extra. We are so grateful for the generosity of our congregation! Calvin remains financially sound, even though overall funding for this fiscal year is less than we had projected.

As of May 31st, general fund revenue is \$45,800 under budget. But the fiscal year is not over yet - June is often one of our strongest months, and there is still one more week. Be sure to fulfill your pledges and donate extra if you can!

We are still working on the budget for our next fiscal year, which starts in July. Although typically the budget is finished in June, this year we will wait to see how the fiscal year ends before finalizing the budget. So mid-July is when Session will make the final choices about funding. Please continue to pray for Calvin's financial decisions:

- Pray that the Holy Spirit will give our leaders wisdom and direction for the budget, including any necessary cuts:
- Pray that we will all be good stewards of the money entrusted to us;
- Pray for the right mix of boldness and caution; and
- Pray that God will provide the resources needed to support Calvin's ministries.

In all things, we give thanks to God. He has always been faithful in providing for our congregation's needs.

// Here are the numbers for July 2023 - April 2024

- General Fund Contributions: \$557,167 (our budget hoped for \$603,000);
- Facilities Revenue: \$74,446 (again beating our budgeted \$65,200);
- Other Revenue: \$48,079;
- **Total Operations Revenue:** \$679.692:
- Total Expenses: \$708,234 (giving to missions \$78,154);

 Net Revenue: \$(28,542); and Total Assets: \$964,400.
