September Finance Summary

// Things are looking good with God's grace and your generosity

For September, we came within "spitting distance" of matching our budgeted goals for General Fund income. This is again good news, and we are so grateful for your generosity. We are thankful that God uses your open hands and hearts to supply our needs.

Please do continue to pray for Calvin's financial health. As mentioned last month, we are not currently in financial distress or danger; however, we are operating on a deficit and losing money every month. We can operate on a deficit for a little while, but eventually there will have to be change — either more income, or less programs and staffing. (Our current financial plan defines that "little while" as within the next year or two.)

// The numbers for July- September

- · General fund contributions: \$136.266:
- Facilities revenue: \$34,641;
- Other revenue: \$13,811;
- Total operations revenue: \$184,718;
- Total expenses: \$206,052 (giving to missions: \$19,140);
- Net revenue: \$(21,334); andTotal assets: \$942,689.

Although our finance summaries typically only report on the state of the General Fund, the letter Calvin sent out in late September mentioned the financial concerns of two our help ministries, Backpack Kids and the Deacons. We received a flood of generosity in response to this letter! Both ministries gained a substantial bump in September as compared

to their usual monthly donations. It's not enough — yet — to solve their financial concerns, but it's a tremendous start. Thank you for responding so quickly and so generously to this need! See the Friday email for a note from Polly of Backpack Kids and Lisa from the Deacons.

Finally, third-quarter contribution statements were mailed out earlier this week. Just as a reminder, you might notice that some of the account names are slightly different on your statement. Session voted last year to consolidate some restricted funds into larger categories to make the funds more accessible for current needs. The consolidations took effect with this fiscal year and this is the first statement that will reflect those changes.
