Waiting for Christmas

When I was about 10 years old, I begged my parents for Christmas lights to put on our house. They finally caved and bought one single string of colored outdoor lights. Just as important, they let me climb on the roof over our porch to hang them! My grandparents had promised to come for the holidays, so I was eager to surprise them with our new lights.

When the night of their arrival came, I left the porch dark and waited with my face pressed against the front window looking for headlights. Each car that wasn't theirs left me disappointed. But when they finally arrived, I ran to the light switch by the front door and waited impatiently. As they slowly came up the stairs with their suitcases, I flipped on the lights, flung open the door, and shouted, "Merry Christmas!"

My waiting had begun with remembering their promise, and my waiting was satisfied by responding to their presence. I think of that often when I reflect on the meaning of Advent. Advent is a season of waiting. We're not just waiting for Christmas Day. We are also waiting for Christ to come again.

I want to use these days to remember God's promises, including those not yet fully realized: promises of healing, joy, hope, reconciliation, and more. I need to remember that from my childlike view, God can move even slower than my grandparents did. I also want to recognize and respond when I see that God is already present now. Jesus, the light of the world, opens the door for us to enter God's presence. Jesus is Emmanuel, God with us. With me. With you.
