November Finance Summary and Year-End Gifts

// December donations make all the difference

Advent is a time of joyful anticipation, a time to bless those around us, and a time to be blessed. It is also traditionally the time at Calvin when we prayerfully consider God's call to share those blessings through our stewardship of time and resources. When we generously give back to God, we can expect blessings in return: a growing faith, a more joyful nature, a diminishing dependence on worldly things, a deeper dependence on God, and much, much more.

December giving to Calvin is always critical to fully funding

our ministries. So please spend time in prayer in the coming days to discern God's stewardship call to you. Consider a special yearend gift to Calvin. If you're 70½ or older, you can make a yearend gift from your IRA account and satisfy your required minimum distribution. Don't be afraid to "test" God and then in the coming months watch closely for His blessings.

Here are the numbers for July – November 2024:

- General Fund Contributions: \$234,016 (97% of our targeted income of \$242,000);
- Facilities Revenue: \$48,056 (still way ahead of our budgeted \$33,750);
- Other Revenue: \$22,687;
- Total Operations Revenue: \$304,759;
- Total Expenses: \$336,862 (giving to missions: \$29,783);
- NET REVENUE: \$(32,103); and
- Total Assets: \$923,940.

There are fewer people supporting Calvin this year as opposed to last year and the year before. However, God does continue to provide for us. We are so thankful for His faithfulness and for your generosity. Many families have committed to increased giving in 2025. Many responded generously when the financial concerns of the Deacons and Backpack Kids were made known. Thank you for your prayers. Thank you for your open hands and hearts!

We appreciate all those who have sent in pledges for General Fund giving in 2025. It's not too late to send in a commitment card if you have not yet done so! Although the General Fund doesn't sound very exciting, this is what pays all our bills, keeping the facility open and the lights on, funding our mission partners and all our ministries, and paying our staff salaries.

There are also a number of items and projects on the wish list for our Facilities Team, but we simply do not have the funding for them out of this year's General Fund budget. However, we do have a fund that is *only* for Building and Grounds. It would be terrific to take advantage of holiday promotions for some of these wish list items — but we need a Santa to help!
