Emergency Contact Initiative

// Don't be a lost sheep!

Calvin pastors and deacons aren't always aware of difficult situations that arise when you are unable to contact the church, such as an illness, hospitalization, or death. In such circumstances, it's possible for you to become "lost"!

Under privacy laws, hospitals and residential institutions *cannot* share with us your status or current location. Also, your loved ones may not yet be aware of your relationship to Calvin or your church's name. To resolve this issue, we are asking the congregation to:

- Provide your emergency contact, for staff and deacon use only; and
- Ask your emergency contact to notify the church office in the event of your hospitalization, illness, or death.

For the next two Sundays (today and February 23), Jean Johnson

and Ruth Van Dyke will be in the foyer before and after the service, seeking people to participate in our "Lost Sheep" Emergency Contact Initiative. If you are unable to join us in person during the next two Sundays, the deacons have committed to contacting the people on their care lists by phone, email, and personal visits to make our data collection more complete.

While your participation is optional, we hope you will enable us to better care for you by providing this information.
