



Matthew 6:19–34

Suggested Questions for Individual
Study or Group Discussion*



- What are some things that you treasure? How do you seek to keep them safe and why?
- *Read Matthew 6:19–34.* What themes run between Jesus' teaching on treasuring (v. 19) and seeking (v. 33)? What connections do you see?
- When Jesus contrasts having good or bad eyes with having light or darkness within us, what does he want us to see? What choices is he asking us to make?
- Why can we not serve both God and money? What happens when we try? How have you seen this play out in your own life or in others?
- In light of what Jesus has said about treasures, eyes, and masters, why might people be worrying about food and clothing? What reasons does Jesus give for *not* worrying?
- About what things do you find yourself frequently worrying? What might Jesus say to you about your worries? What would he suggest you do instead?
- What are treasures in heaven, and how are they stored up (v. 20)? How does someone seek first the kingdom of heaven (v. 33)? What attitudes and habits would characterize someone who does this?
- How did Jesus embody his own teaching here? What examples can you see in Jesus' life?
- What is the Lord saying to you through this Scripture? How will you respond this week to what you're hearing and learning? How can your small group or others support and pray for you as you do?
