Cybersecurity Tips

// How to spot red flags from email scammers

Over the past couple of weeks, we've seen a number of email scams from people posing as members or staff of Calvin Presbyterian Church. These

scams have already caught a couple of people.

Here are some friendly email safety reminders:

- Beware of poor grammar, misspelled words, and lack of punctuation — these are giveaways of fraudulent emails.
- Double check the actual email addresses and make sure they are the right email addresses.
- Unless you know the sender and have verified the sender's email address, do not open any attachments.
- No one from the church is ever going to email you or text you to ask you to get a gift card from Costco or Amazon or any other place. If you see that, don't believe it.
- Change your email password regularly and do not use the same password for different accounts or websites.
