// Robust contributions made for a great month!

May contributions to the General Fund were strong. We still have a deficit, of course, but our current deficit of \$30,394 is less than half of our projected May deficit of \$62,159. This leaves us in a *great* position for the final month of our fiscal year. We are grateful to God for his provision, and to all of you for your generosity.

Calvin is going through some transitions; as a result, our budget is still in process. Please continue to pray for wisdom and discernment for our church leaders as they finalize the figures for the coming fiscal year.
