June Finance Summary

// Thank you for your generosity

We are grateful that so many of you fulfilled your pledges and others sent in extra donations in June! Thanks to your generosity and faithfulness, June was a very strong month. Our fiscal year ended much better than we anticipated. We ended with a deficit, but a smaller one than we expected. That's really good news! We also exceeded our targeted goals for both contributions and facilities revenue.

The good news continues. The strong fiscal year end made it easier to plan the budget, and so earlier this week Session adopted a budget for the 2025–26 fiscal year. This budget includes

funding to support Session's decisions regarding our vacant Associate Pastor position. It gives a cost-of-living increase to our hard-working staff and it provides funding increases to our valuable mission partners.

We do anticipate that this budget will also include a modest deficit, but we have adequate reserves to cover that deficit. Some technology needs were left out of the budget, however, as they may require special funding. Continue to pray for the budget and any special funding that may be required. Your prayer support means more than you may realize.

We continue to give thanks to God for his faithfulness in providing for the needs of our congregation.

- Facilities Revenue: \$93,240 beating the annual goal by over \$7K;
- Other Revenue: \$54,133;
- Total Operations Revenue: \$803,587;
- Total Expenses: \$841,362 giving to missions: \$76,965;
- GF Net Revenue: \$(37,775); and
- Total Assets: \$917,487.
