// New fiscal year begins

We are once again at the beginning of a new fiscal year, with new budget targets and a new spending plan. As you heard last month, the new budget includes funding to support Session's decisions regarding our vacant Associate Pastor position. Staff and our mission partners all have received a cost-of-living increase.

Although we did not meet this month's target for general fund contributions, for the first time in two years we have a positive net revenue balance! That is terrific news for the start of a new fiscal year! We give thanks

to God for his faithfulness, and thanks to you for your generosity.
