We are thrilled that Messy Church is soon beginning its fourth year at Calvin Church! In a gracious and timely answer to much prayer, we are pleased to welcome Curtis White to our Messy Church leadership team. August Finance Summary

// Calvin finances are a little low, but healthy

August contributions to the General Fund were typical for the summertime - a little on the light side. We reached 89% of our targeted income. Expenses were higher than our income, so we are back to running a small deficit. Again, this is expected. The good news is that the deficit is about half of what we thought it would be. Our Facilities revenue is also stellar, mostly due to an annual pre-payment by one of our long-term quest users. Still, we anticipate that this is only the start of a good year for Facilities income.

As Norm reported elsewhere, we did receive some grant money for various community projects. This money goes into our restricted

funds and cannot be used for general operating expenses.

// Here are the numbers for July – August 2025

- General Fund Contributions: \$89,260 – 89% of target income;
- Facilities Revenue: \$19,676 better than expected due to pre-payment;
- Other Revenue: \$8,643;
- Total Operations Revenue: \$117,579;
- Total Expenses: \$126,025 giving to missions: \$11,436;
- GF Net Revenue: \$(8,446); and
- Total Assets: \$905,595.

Bridge's Ministries Medical Equipment Program is a bridge to physical access in the world. Their Medical Equipment Ministry gave away over \$2 million in durable medical equipment to over 2,000 people last year.

Calvin and Bridge have a significant partnership that spans two decades. On Sunday, September 28, Calvin will host a Sunday Evening Celebration, a time of fellowship, food, and fun that connects our congregants with people Bridge serves.
